What is a Pack Away Helper?

A Pack Away Helper is required from 5:30pm until approximately 9:00pm, following the announcements from the competition announcer about which sites are ready to be cleared. The role involves packing away equipment and returning it to the shed, with guidance provided by the Pack Away Manager or a Committee Member. This role is ideal for anyone who can commit to staying until the end of the competition and is a great way to be part of the behind-the-scenes action with the committee afterwards.



What are the requirements to being a Pack Away Helper?

- Be available from 5:30pm until approximately 9:00pm or until all equipment is packed away.
- Listen for announcements from the competition announcer regarding which sites are ready to be cleared.
- This role involves physical tasks such as dismantling equipment for field events, shade tents, hurdles, dragging back high jump mats, and setting down discus nets, so it's important that volunteers are comfortable with the physical demands to ensure the workload is shared evenly amongst the team
- Follow guidance from the Pack Away Manager or a Committee Member on the correct procedures for packing and storing equipment.
- Be prepared for physical tasks, as the role involves lifting and moving equipment.
- Must be able to commit to staying until the end of the competition to ensure everything is packed away efficiently.

By following these steps and maintaining a positive attitude, we can ensure that all equipment is packed away efficiently, preventing delays and ensuring we finish at a reasonable time. When everyone pitches in, the workload becomes lighter, and the process goes much faster – truly demonstrating that many hands make light work.
